

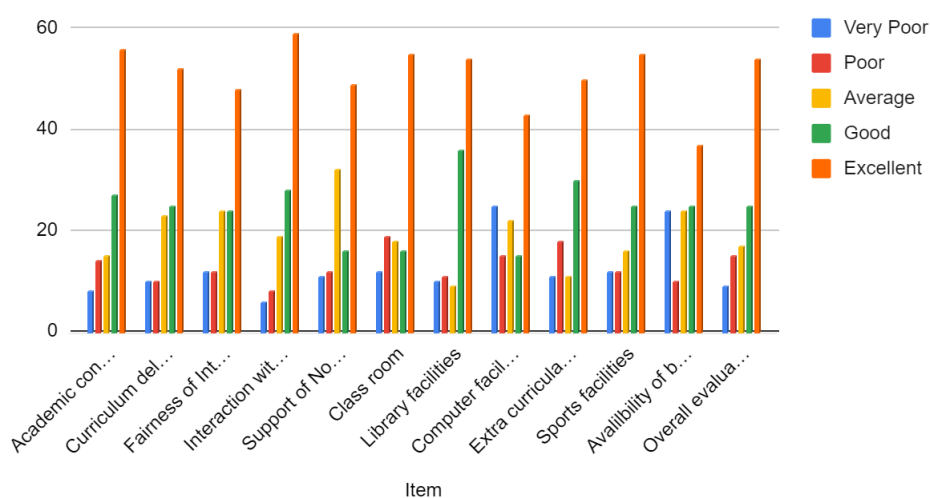
Stakeholder's Feedback analysis (2023-24)

Feedback Analysis of Students for 2023-24



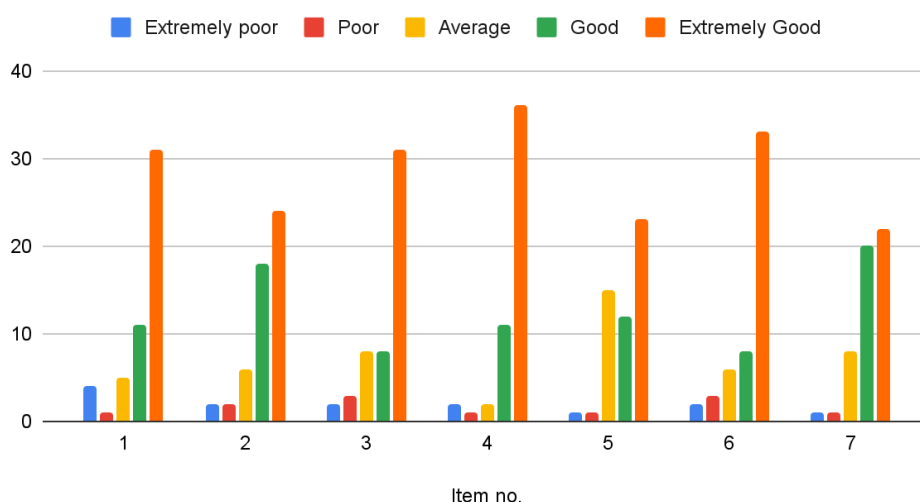
On an average 45% students assess the syllabus and its transaction Excellent, 21% as Good and 14 % as Average. Almost 20% are not satisfied with the syllabus and its transaction at the institute.

Alumni Feedback Analysis 2023-24



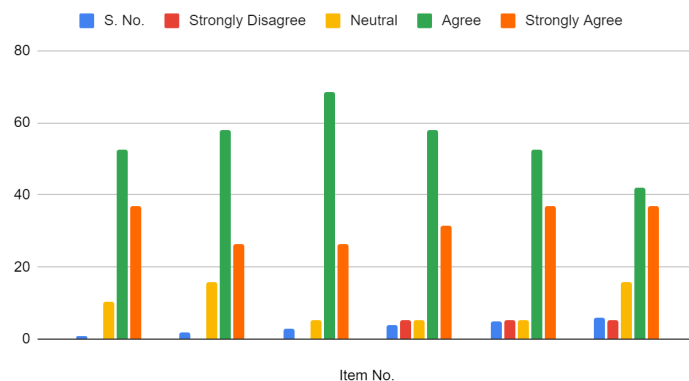
Overall 42% of alumni rated the college extremely good, 38% of them rated it good, 16% as Average. 4% of the alumni have given overall grading of the college as poor.

Teachers' Feedback

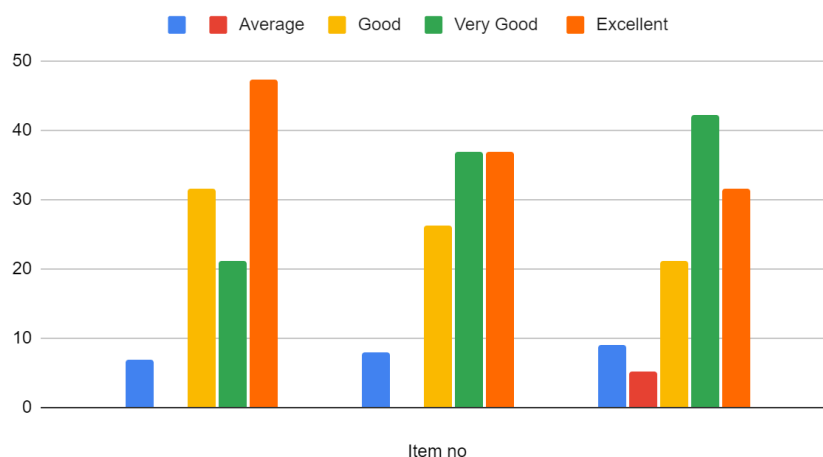

Further all the stakeholders were asked to put their suggestions regarding curriculum at the end of their feedback form, those suggestions are summarized as follows:

1. Curriculum should involve more field work/project work as a part of syllabus.
2. More employment based courses should be introduced.
3. The college should encourage the practice of field visits and experiential learning.
4. Non teaching staff should be more supportive.
5. Basic facilities and requirements must be taken care of by the college authorities for students and staff.

Action Taken Report

Our college is a Govt. aided college, which is affiliated to Ch bansi Lal University. We adhere to the curriculum prescribed by the university only and have no choice to change it in any case. So we can not alter the Syllabus in any form. The faculty prepares a teaching plan for effective delivery of the curriculum in each aspect.
